Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1:

Arrival to Tripoli Airport where Our Guide will Meet you with Board written your name in, whom will assist for getting Visa upon arrival, transfer to the hotel, afternoon city sightseeing Tour visit The Marcus Aurelius Arch, Modern Medina overnight at hotel.

Day 2:

Visit Aljamahirya Museum is one of Essential attraction for sightseeing tour to Libya; the museum shows monuments of civilizations that inhabited Libya by Germants, Roman, Greek, Phoenician & Islamic. Our Local guide will accompany you & to Enjoy listening to the interesting & a brief explanation about the ancient civilization. Our Second point of the city sightseeing tour is visiting the Karamanly house Which Is one of the most important historical houses in the street of Arbaa Aarsaat.

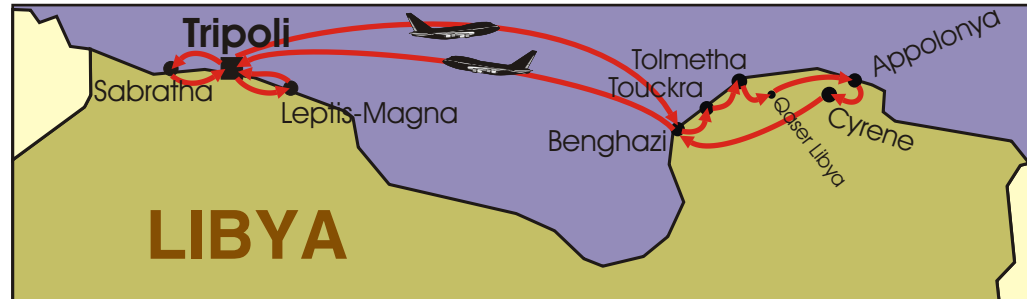
It was built in the 2nd half of the 18th century A.D. During the reign of Ali Pasha Al Karamanly from 1754 to 1793. It was known as Al Hareem house because the famous governor of Tripoli Usef Pasha Karamanly (1798-1832) was living in this house with his big family.

The Third point of our tour Drive to Sabratha (62 Km.) Having Lunch in a tourist Restaurant, drive to the site to begin touring in the ancient Roman city & it's museum with & a brief explanation of our Local Guide. return to Tripoli, overnight at hotel.

Day 3:

Excursion to *Leptis-Magna* (120 Km.); the most preserved Roman site, the city was originally a Phoenician port, settled during the first millennium BC. Slaves, gold, ivory and precious metals brought it great wealth, which was supplement by the rich agricultural land surrounding it. Roman legions ousted the *Carthaginians* following the third Punic War, after which the city flourished until the Vandals did their namesake thing in 455 AC.

The first thing you'll encounter is the Severan Arch, which was erected in honor of Emperor Septimus Severus' visit



to his hometown in 203 AD. Not far off are the marble and granite paneled Hadrianic Baths, the largest outside Rome. Keep exploring and you'll come across the partially covered nymphaeum, a shrine dedicated to the worship of nymphs; a pair of massive forums, similar in design and grandiosity to the imperial forum in Rome; the extraordinarily detailed basilica and theatre.

Having Lunch, Continue our tour to the west along the seashore about 700 m, the circus and amphitheatre, where chariot races and similar spectacles were held for the locals' amusement. Drive to Villa Sillin visit the wonderful mosaic, return to Tripoli, overnight at hotel.

Day 4:

Flight to Benghazi, touring in the city souq & the Commonwealth cemetery, Dinner and overnight at Auzu Hotel.



Day 5:

Drive to Appolonya (Susah-222 Km.) via Touckra & Tolmetha & Qaser Libya visit the sites & the museum, overnight at hotel.

Day 6:

Visit Cyrene ancient harbor of Apollinya the city was the harbor for Cyrene, 18 km & most of what the site contains belongs to the Byzantine era (from 5th to 6th

century AD) when Apollonia was known as the "city of churches". It had five basilicas and 19 towers.

Afternoon excursion will be the ancient Greek city of Cyrene which locates at 222 Km. Eastern Benghazi, it was the oldest and most important of the five Greek cities in the region and gave eastern Libya the classical name 'Cyrenaica'. One of its more significant features is the Temple of Apollo which was originally constructed as early as 7th century BC. Other ancient structures include a Temple to Demeter and a partially un excavated Temple to Zeus There is a large necropolis approximately 10 km² between Cyrene and its ancient port of Apollonia., Overnight at hotel.

Day 7:

Drive back to Benghazi via Slunta Site, flight to Tripoli, overnight at hotel.

Day 8:

Leisure touring day, Dinner and overnight at hotel.

Day 9:

Departure & End Of Services.
